The Zoroastrian Trust Funds of Europe (ZTFE) was established in London in 1861, by far sighted visionary Zoroastrians including Seth Muncherji Hormusji Cama and Dr Dadabhai Naoroji. In 1861 there were 50 Zoroastrians in the UK, while today there are around 5000 Parsee and Irani Zoroastrians. The ZTFE manages a separate Zoroastrian Cemetery acquired in 1863 and the Zoroastrian Centre for Europe – a large Place of Worship and community centre purchased in 2000 through the generosity of the **Zartoshty Brothers**.

In order to provide for the community's religious needs the ZTFE is supported by a number of voluntary priests who have provided decades of exemplary service to the community. Our core team of Ervad Sahebs who perform the bulk of the Jashans are senior and the team now requires a fulltime Ervad. Besides performing an Ervad's general duties such as performing jashans, navjotes, ashirwads, geh sarnas and uthamnas, the successful candidate must be computer literate. He will act as an effective resource for the Zoroastrian Community to provide a pastoral care service to our old and infirmed members. He will provide a regular communication channel to such old people ensuring that their spiritual and emotional needs are taken care of. In addition to this primary function, the Mobed will also represent the ZTFE at various local and national religious community events.



The post initially for 2 years is for a full time Zoroastrian Mobed as well as a Pastor, Counsellor, Chaplain, Social Worker and Religious Teacher for the Parsee and Irani Zoroastrian Community in the UK. Besides being a Navar and Martab qualified Zoroastrian Ervad, the successful candidate must be a graduate with a good command of English, Gujarati and preferably Persian. He must be able to combine the role of Counsellor to the very aged and the very young and also act as a Teacher and Guide of basic Zoroastrian heritage, culture, history and religion. Hence the successful candidate will be a multi disciplined Zoroastrian Ervad who would see this as a labour of love, thus having the passion to serve the ZTFE as well as Parsee and Irani Zoroastrian Community in the UK.
