

## JAPANESE GOVERNMENT (MONBUKAGAKUSHO: MEXT) SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2014

The MEXT (Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) offers scholarships to international students who wish to study in Japan under the Japanese Government (JGSE) Scholarship Program.

### Field of Study

#### UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

##### 1. Social Sciences and Humanities

Social Sciences and Humanities - A: Law, Politics, Pedagogy, Sociology, Literature, History, Japanese Language and others.  
Social Sciences and Humanities - B: Economics and Business Administration

##### 2. Natural Sciences

Natural Sciences - A: Science (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry), Electric and Electronic Studies (Electronics, Electrical Engineering, Information Engineering), Mechanical Studies (Mechanical Engineering, Naval Architecture), Civil Engineering and Architecture (Civil Engineering, Architecture, Environmental Engineering), Chemical Studies (Applied Chemistry, Chemical Engineering, Industrial Chemistry, Textile Engineering) and other fields (Metallurgical Engineering, Mining Engineering, Maritime Engineering, Biotechnology).

Natural Sciences - B: Agricultural Studies (Agriculture, Agricultural Chemistry, Agricultural Engineering, Animal Science, Veterinary Medicine, Forestry, Food Science, Fisheries), Hygienic Studies (Pharmacy, Hygienics, Nursing) and Science (Biology).

Natural Sciences - C: Medicine and Dentistry.

Scholarship awards will be tenable for 5 years from April 2014 to March 2019, including one year preparatory education in the Japanese language and other subjects due to be provided upon arrival in Japan. For scholarship grantees majoring in medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine or a 6 year course in pharmacy, the term of scholarship will be 7 years until March 2021.

#### COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY STUDENTS

(1) Mechanical Engineering (2) Electrical and Electronic Engineering (3) Information, Communication and Network Engineering (4) Materials Engineering (5) Architecture and Civil Engineering (6) Maritime Engineering (7) Other Fields

Scholarship awards will be tenable for 4 years from April, 2014 to March, 2018 including one year preparatory education in the Japanese language and other subjects due to be provided upon arrival in Japan. For scholarship grantees majoring in maritime engineering, the term of scholarship will be 4 ½ years upto September, 2018.

#### SPECIALIZED TRAINING COLLEGE STUDENTS

(1) Personal Care and Nutrition (2) Education and Welfare (3) Business (4) Fashion and Home Electronics (5) Culture and General Education (6) Other Fields

Scholarship awards will be tenable for 3 years from April 2014 to March 2017 including one year preparatory education in the Japanese language and other subjects due to be provided upon arrival in Japan.

### Qualifications

**Nationality:** Applicant must be an Indian or of any other nationality which has diplomatic relations with the Japanese government.

**Age:** Applicant must be born between April 2, 1992 and April 1, 1997.

**Academic Background:** Applicant must have completed a 12 year school curriculum or graduated from a school equivalent to an upper secondary school in Japan by March, 2014.

**Japanese Language:** Applicant must be willing to learn the Japanese language and receive education in Japanese.

### Scholarship Benefits

**Allowance:** Under fiscal 2013 budget, a grantee will be paid ¥117,000 per month (with an additional monthly stipend of 2,000 or 3,000 yen for those undertaking study or research in specially designated regions which would be subject to change depending upon the annual budget of each year).

### Application Deadline

Application must reach the Consulate General of Japan not later than **Friday, June 21, 2013**
