- Dialogue with leaders committed to a strong call for action, so as to equip young people in the best practices of interfaith peace building and protecting the earth.

### Cultivate Leadership and Amplify Impact

- Cultivate leadership through moments of service learning, where participants are challenged to put ideals into action during the conference and beyond.
- A select few participants will travel to Paris to attend the Conference of Parties meeting in December 2015, and will be featured on Earth - Faith - Peace blogs and social media.
